Performance Notes

-It is desirable that this "double" fauxbourdon be sung as indicated, but the director should feel free to adjust the form of the Antiphon repetition and verses as needed.

-Rubato should be given to the unmetered portions of the text.

-The ends of phrases should be approached gently with a slight decrescendo.

-The symbol " | " in the psalmody is a slight pause for a choral breath.

-Staggered breathing is expected where a breath mark is not indicated.

Translation of Psalmody

1. *I will bless the Lord at all times, his praise shall be always in my mouth.*
